Responses to Jesus varied, especially when He used figurative language and made exclusive claims. Last week we looked at Grumblers and Disputers. This passage gives the account of when Grumblers choose to become Quitters. It also tells us of the Twelve Disciples who choose to go with Jesus.

Choosing to Walk Away from Jesus

Many take offense at Jesus and the claims He makes

The offense of the cross is the deciding factor

Seeing miraculous spiritual events is ineffectual by itself

Spiritual Awakening to Jesus

The Holy Spirit gives life – all of grace, not us

The words of Jesus are spirit and life

Jesus knows "from the beginning" - divine omniscience

Triune God is revealed: The Spirit gives life to us The Father draws us to Jesus The Son gives His life for us

Choosing to Follow Jesus

The ultimate question in life is about Jesus

Faith is ongoing trust in the integrity of Jesus

Jesus has the words of eternal life

Jesus is the Holy One of God

Eternity with Jesus is the greatest treasure we can seek
