Jesus and the writers of the New Testament are very clear about the beauty and power of God's forgiveness and the necessity of us forgiving others. *(Matthew 18:21-35; Luke 6:37, 17:1-5, 23:34; Ephesians 4:30-32; Hebrews 12:11-15)*

Living by the Grace Principle

Our sin debt to God is infinite God's grace through Christ is infinite and effective We acknowledge our sin (repent) and trust in Christ's work Grace opens our hearts to be conduits of God's grace Denying the grace principle creates a boomerang effect

Stop and gain perspective Drop to your knees and pray for the Holy Spirit's help Roll with God's amazing grace

We gain relief from a bitter spirit We experience assurance of God's forgiveness We display God's rich mercy working through us We participate in the ripple effect of grace
